



Medication Safety Patrol: Trivia Game

Time

20-30 minutes

Synopsis

Participants work in teams to solve a variety of trivia questions related to pharmacy and safe medication-taking practices.

Materials

- Pencils or pens
- One “Participant Worksheet” per group (3-4 participants/group)

Instructions

1. Divide participants into groups. Provide each group with a “Participant Worksheet”.
2. Each group takes turns choosing a category and a point value that corresponds to a specific question.
3. Click on the selected point value. Read the statement and ask each group to write the answer on their answer sheet.
4. For those groups that answer correctly, they will earn the corresponding amount of points.
5. In order to go back to the game board, click on the ‘answer’ slide.
6. Continue playing until all questions are answered. Then, click the ‘Final Question’ box on the game board. Ask each group to wager all or a portion of their earned points.
7. Ask the ‘Final Question’ and allow each group to answer. Tally the earned points for each group and determine a winner.

Final Trivia Answer

Sharing medicine or taking a prescription medicine not prescribed for you. Kim should have notified a trusted adult that Sara needed help.

Technology Limitations

If technology is limited, consider re-creating the trivia game board on a magnetic white board or chalkboard using paper. On separate sheets of paper, write the question on one side and answer on the other side. Play according to the above instructions.
