

### Purpose

This interactive activity is to review and enforce the information in the “Getting the Best Results from Your Medications” presentation.

### Time to Complete the Activity: 25–45 minutes

### Materials:

- Powerpoint presentation
- Whiteboard or poster board to keep score
- Directions for Facilitators
- Small prize for the winners (optional)

### Directions for the Facilitators:

- Explain to participants there is only one board of questions with 5 different categories and one Final Jeopardy question. Whichever group ends with the most points will be the winner. (However, all are winners as they have gained useful information!)
- Designate a scorekeeper either on a whiteboard or poster board.
- Divide participants into groups. Suggest only 2-3 groups to keep game moving along.
- Pick a team spokesperson to answer in question format for the team.
- Assign or pick team names.
- Determine which group is going to select first.
- Begin by having the first team select the category and point value.
- When time is running out or when the entire board has been gone through, go to the Final Jeopardy “wager” slide in “Slide Show” view.

*When clicking on the slide to move to the next appropriate slide, be sure you see the hand, not the arrow. (If you put your cursor over a text box, it will be an arrow and WILL NOT take you to the right location as you advance slides. You can always go out of Slide Show to get back to the correct spot. Recommend trying this on your own to get used to the set up of the game before using the game.)*
